The buyer understands and agrees to:

1. The seller is not a professional tailor.
2. Alterations may be required by a professional tailor or seamstress at the cost of the buyer.
3. A non-refundable deposit will be required prior to starting the work.
4. The non-refundable deposit shall be in the sum of the estimate provided by the seller for cloth, materials and administrative processes.
5. Complete the measurement chart and provide it to the seller.
6. The items provided shall be of a general clothing fit commonly known as Small-Medium-Large-Extra Large- Double Extra Large.
7. Pay the seller, less deposit, on confirmation the goods have been transferred to Canada Post for delivery.
8. Insure the shipment for double the cost of the item.
This will protect both parties incase of loss or damage.

The Seller understands and agrees to:

1. Provide the goods and services in good faith.
2. Complete the goods thirty days, not including Saturday and Sunday, from the commencement of the contract.
3. Provide the buyer regular updates with photos sent by electronic means.
4. Provide the goods and services to the same degree of skill as the photographs seen by the buyer prompting this contact.
5. Provide an estimate of cloth, materials and administrative processes to the buyer prior to commencing work.
6. Communicate with the buyer should any unreasonable delays occur and provide a reason for the delay.
7. Provide a discount of twenty percent against the cost of labour if the buyer is Canadian Forces Veteran. Proof of service is required
